On March 2, 2023 the South Kingstown Town Council unanimously voted to place a bond referendum on the ballot later this year for South Kingstown voters to decide to fund an up to \$125 million bond to build a new high school at the current high school location on Columbia Street and new athletic facilities at the location where Curtis Corner Middle School is located.

The SK School Building Committee will be meeting regularly over the next several months to plan for the bond referendum and provide information to the community about the plan and process.
